

Residents raise concerns over possible mental health cuts

A group of citizens concerned about looming state budget cuts to mental health programs gathered at the Coffee County Training Center on Friday to seek answers from Alabama Sen. Jimmy Holley.

Holley, who attended the forum to answer questions and listen to concerns, said he wasn't sure how the state's budget would end up – only that the state senate was 'waiting for a plan' from the House of Representatives, which generates revenue bills.
