Widely known as the birthplace of both the Civil War and the Civil Rights Movement, Montgomery has preserved much of its history through its numerous museums, memorials and attractions.. Let the Montgomery Area Visitor Center help make the most of your play time. Located in historic Union Station in downtown Montgomery, the Visitor Center can help plan your itinerary and put together a ticket package to area attractions. You can also hop aboard the Lighting Route Trolley from the Visitor Center for passage to Montgomery's downtown destinations. One of the few state capitols designated a National Historic Landmark, the Alabama State Capitol is where Jefferson Davis took the oath of office as president of the Confederate States of America and where the Selma-to-Montgomery Civil Rights March ended with Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. delivering a moving speech from the bottom of its steps.

### **Rosa Parks Library & Museum and Children's Wing**

Visitors to this fascinating interactive museum are able to put themselves in the place of Rosa Parks, who sparked the Montgomery Bus Boycott in 1955. Additional exhibits lead visitors on an emotional journey through the days of the Bus Boycott, which became the first step on the often difficult path to civil rights in America. The Children's Wing provides a museum experience that is tailored specifically for children's age and comprehensive abilities. Through the use of a "time machine," the Children's Wing prepares visitors for the museum reenactment experience. A scholar's research area that captures the history of Montgomery and the Civil Rights Movement features artifacts, oral histories, historical documents and art for high school students and adults.

**Dexter Avenue King Memorial Baptist Church and Parsonage**

In this National Historic Landmark, see the modest pulpit where the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. first preached his message of hope and brotherhood, and visit the parsonage where he lived with his family. The church was also a center point of the Montgomery Bus Boycott. A large mural in the church depicts King's civil rights crusade from Montgomery to Memphis.

**Civil Rights Memorial & Center**

Water flows over a table inscribed with the names of those who died during the modern civil rights movement. The wall behind the table is inscribed with excerpts from the Book of Amos quoted in the historical speech by Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. The Civil Rights Memorial Center expands the experience of the Memorial by honoring the memory and achievements of those who lost their lives during the Civil Rights Movement. In addition to state-of-the-art exhibits and in-depth information about Civil Rights Movement martyrs, the Civil Rights Memorial Center houses a 69-seat theater, a classroom for educational activities, a section dedicated to contemporary social justice issues, and the Wall of Tolerance.
