**QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from a recognized school of pharmacy.

**NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Currently licensed to practice pharmacy in good standing with the Alabama State Board of Pharmacy.

**KIND OF WORK:** Procure pharmaceuticals for the consumers of North Alabama Regional Hospital through contract, from wholesalers, and locally so that quality medication may be provided at a reasonable price. Fill and dispense medication so that the consumers may receive maximum care. Maintain inventory of medication so that accountability is provided at all times. Provide inservice to staff about medications used at North Alabama Regional Hospital, and consult with physicians and nurses regarding individual medications and treatments whenever necessary. Maintains drug formularies so that duplication of product is eliminated, inventory is reduced, and cost for providing services to patients is minimized. Must be knowledgeable of current pharmaceutical information including laws, ordinances, and rules so that a high level of professionalism may be maintained. Maintain unit dose, stock Docu-Med cabinet and emergency kits. Monitor pharmacy inventory for outdated drugs.

**REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:** Knowledge of current pharmaceutical information, including laws, ordinances, and applicable standards. Ability to communicate both orally and in writing. Ability to maintain and foster contact with drug representatives and suppliers. Knowledge of Joint Commission and applicable standards. Experience in pharmaceutical practice in hospital setting.

**METHOD OF SELECTION:** Applicants will be rated on the basis of an evaluation of their training, experience and education and should provide adequate work history identifying experiences related to the duties and minimum qualifications as stated above. All relevant information is subject to verification. **Drug screenings and security clearances will be conducted on prospective applicants being given serious consideration for employment and whose job requires direct contact with patients.**
