

Local groups target underage drinking in Auburn

During the month of October, the Auburn Police Division and the Prevention Services Department of East Alabama Mental Health will provide increased monitoring and public education regarding underage drinking in the Auburn Downtown Business District.

Extra officers have been assigned to foot and vehicle patrols in the downtown areas which have a high concentration of alcohol consumption. Members of the EAMH Prevention Services Department will also be on hand to provide educational information to citizens in the area, while APD officers patrol the area for alcohol violations.
