Individuals with disabilities spend a lot of time preparing for employment and learning how to get their "foot in the door" with employers. Time is spent acquiring the skills needed to perform job tasks, searching for job vacancies and applying for jobs. However, individuals with disabilities, and their service providers, spend little time preparing for the "next steps" in landing the job once they get their "foot in the door." Being unprepared in knowing when and how to talk about one's disability in the interview process could mean the difference in having the door closed on getting the job or being "invited in" the door to work. This training will assist in preparing participants in

- Discussing, or preparing others to discuss, their disability in an interview
- Asking for, or preparing others to ask for reasonable accommodations in the job application process and/or once employed, and
- Completing, or preparing others to complete, self-identification forms and requests for reasonable accommodations.
